

## Improving child welfare response

In response to legislative changes, the Kentucky team has worked to make updates to the child welfare reporting system to distinguish trafficking cases from neglect cases. When these changes were implemented, Kentucky developed reports that can be run monthly to track human trafficking cases and outcomes over time (including wellness, permanency, safety, and educational measures) captured as part of case management.

## Increasing victim identification

The Kentucky team has increased the knowledge and the capacity of child welfare responders across the **state.** The Kentucky team developed and released a policy and protocol for screening and service planning that included a mandatory screening at certain timepoint/events. The Kentucky DCBS released a training that is mandatory for all DCBS staff and all child-serving staff at partner agencies who provide placement and treatment to youth in out-of-home care. The two trainings have been completed over 15,000 times. As

a result, DCBS has seen an increase in identification of trafficking both at the screening schedule and outside of those times.
