The Louisiana Child and Youth
Trafficking Collaborative Accessibility
Initiative (LCYTC-AI) is managed by the
Louisiana Governor's Office of Human
Trafficking Prevention (OHTP) and the
Louisiana Alliance of Children's
Advocacy Centers. It has been successful
in creating an effective statewide system
of equitable care coordination for minor
and youth victims of human trafficking.

For the LCYTC-AI, Louisiana recognized a need to improve response to underidentified trafficking victims, particularly labor and family-facilitated trafficking victims.

## WHAT IS IMPROVING OUTCOMES?

The Improving Outcomes for Child and Youth Victims of Human Trafficking grant program supports state and tribal responses for children and youth victims of trafficking. This program is funded by the Office for Victims of Crime at the Department of Justice.

## Developing state-level partnerships

Key to the success of the LCYTC-AI is the collaboration between public and private partners.

The OHTP facilitates the Human Trafficking Prevention Commission and Advisory Board. The Commission includes leadership from the Office of Juvenile Justice, Department of Children

and Family Services, Louisiana State Police, Department of Education, Louisiana Department of Health and more. The Advisory Board comprises direct service providers, survivor leaders, and advocacy groups.

## Sustaining and expanding child trafficking response systems

Since the initial round of OVC funding, Louisiana has successfully allocated over 2.5 million dollars annually in state funding to create a centralized human trafficking reporting and referral process and to expand care coordination services through Act 662 and the

LCYTC. Furthermore, this funding supports 19 regional navigators who coordinate trafficking-specific multidisciplinary teams and service provision for minor victims of human trafficking in Louisiana.
